ADVANCING GOD'S KINGDOM

1 Corinthians 3:1-10

And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ.

2. I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able.

3. For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?

4. For while one saith, I am of Paul; and another, I am of Apollos; are ye not carnal?

5. Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man?

6. I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase.

7. So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase.

8. Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour.

9. For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.

10. According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon.

GOD'S CO-LABORERS

2. The first thing I want you to see here is that God's operations on earth is limited to man.

God can't do anything on earth outside of man.

Think about it. For the redemption of man, God Himself had to be born as a man in order for Him to save man.

John 1:1-3,14

1. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

2. The same was in the beginning with God.

3. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

14. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

E. M Bounds said, “while men are looking for better methods, God is looking for better men because men are God's methods.”

Ezek 22:30

And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.

God is still seeking for men/women. God needs men/women

CRITICAL STAKEHOLDERS

Now, in this passage we see three critical stakeholders in the task of advancing of God's kingdom on earth.

There cannot be any advancement in God's kingdom without these three critical stakeholders

1.The Planters

2.The Waterers

3.The Increaser/Advancer

Of course, God is the increaser/Advancer. But without the labors of the Planters and the Waterers, God has nothing to increase.

Exodus 17:8-13

8. Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim.

9. And Moses said unto Joshua, Choose us out men, and go out, fight with Amalek: to morrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in mine hand.

10. So Joshua did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill.

11 . And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

12. But Moses' hands were heavy; and they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon; and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

13. And Joshua discomfited Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword.

How many critical stakeholders can you see here?

1.You see Moses - the planter - the visioner

These are those called into any of the five fold Ministries

Ephesians 4:11

And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

2.You see Aaron and Hur - the Waterers

The Waterers includes every member of the Body of Christ.

Ephesian 4:11-12

And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

3.You see God - The Increaser-The Advancer -The One that make everything happen.

STAKEHOLDER OR PRETENDER

Matthew 9:36-38

36. But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

37. Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the laborers are few;

38. Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth laborers into his harvest.

There are very few laborers - critical stakeholders committed to the advancement of God's kingdom on earth.

That's our pry assignment on earth.

That's the pry reason for our existence on earth.

That's the pry reason for everything God's doing in our lives as believers.

That's the pry reason for our healing, our victories, our deliverance, our progresses, our breakthroughs and preservation in life.

All the blessings, victories etc that we enjoy as God's children are not end in themselves.

All these are means to an end.

The end being the advancement of God's kingdom on earth.

Unfortunately, most believers are pretenders. This is very critical.

WRONG FOCUS

Philippians 2:19-24

19. But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timotheus shortly unto you, that I also may be of good comfort, when I know your state.

20. For I have no man like-minded, who will naturally care for your state.

21. For all seek their own, not the things which are Jesus Christ's.

22. But ye know the proof of him, that, as a son with the father, he hath served with me in the gospel.

23. Him therefore I hope to send presently, so soon as I shall see how it will go with me.

24. But I trust in the Lord that I also myself shall come shortly.

The focus of Believers have totally shifted in this end time.

This is because the focus of many Ministers and Ministries have totally shifted.

Where are those that **NATURALLY** care for the advancement of God's kingdom on earth?

Today, everyone seeks the advancement of their own kingdom.

KEYS TO ADVANCE GOD'S KINGDOM ON EARTH

Revelation 11:15-17

Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!"

16. And the twenty-four elders who sat before God on their thrones fell on their faces and worshiped God,

17. Saying: "We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty, The One who is and who was and who is to come, Because You have taken Your great power and reigned.

There are two kingdoms running parallel in this world.

- 1. The kingdom of this world under the stolen rulership of Satan and his forces.**
- 2. The Kingdom of God under the rulership of Christ.**

Satan established a kingdom on earth when Adam sinned and fell. The authority and dominion God gave to man over the earth passed into the hand of Satan and he established his kingdom here on earth. This kingdom is not physical but spiritual. However it's this spiritual Kingdom that's the power behind every earthly kingdom.

Luke 4:4-8

4. But Jesus answered him, saying, "It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.'"

5. Then the devil, taking Him up on a high mountain, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

6. And the devil said to Him, “All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish.

7. Therefore, if You will worship before me, all will be Yours.”

8. And Jesus answered and said to him, “Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.’”

2 Corinthians 4:3-6

3. But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:

4. In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

5. For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake.

6. For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Christ came to restore the reign of God's kingdom back on earth. The Bible says He went about preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God.

And, now, He has shined in the hearts of every believer to go everywhere to give the light of the knowledge of Christ. Hallelujah.

However, while Satan and his forces are brutally busy advancing his kingdom in all frontiers on earth through his dedicated committed followers, the Church is busy advancing individual kingdoms on earth.

1 Timothy 6:13-15

13. I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and before Christ Jesus, who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;

14. That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:

15. Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords;

16. Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen.

The Gospel is about the advancement of God's kingdom on earth. The kingdom where God is the only Potentate.

Right now God's kingdom is not ruling over all.

This is because by reason of the fall of man in the garden of Eden, the authority and dominion God gave to man passed into the hand of Satan. This is what enabled Satan to establish his own kingdom on earth.

The kingdom of God does not reign in the lives of every man on earth today only in the lives of those who have received Christ as their Lord and Savior.

The reason for our existence as believers is to extend the frontiers of God's kingdom on earth. God must rule and reign over His universe that He created.

This issue is very deep. The only reason for the calamities, storms, tornadoes, and epidemics that's ravaging the earth today is because of the parallel operation of Satan's kingdom in the universe.

People calls these things natural disasters only because of ignorance and spiritual blindness.

Unfortunately, not many people, believers in God's kingdom understand what really is at stake.

KEYS

Let us look at some keys that helps your participation and affects your relevance in the advancement of God's kingdom on earth.

1. Know You are a stakeholder, not just a beneficiary.

1 Corinthians 3:9

9. For we are laborers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.

Not everyone in the Church is a stakeholder. Not everyone is a laborer.

Matthew 9:36-38

36. But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

37. Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few;

38. Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

Many in the Church are pretenders. Mere beneficiaries.

Matthew 14:20-22

20. And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the fragments that remained twelve baskets full.

21. And they that had eaten were about five thousand men, beside women and children.

22. And straightway Jesus constrained his disciples to get into a ship, and to go before him unto the other side, while he sent the multitudes away.

Are you a stakeholder? Or a mere beneficiary and a pretender in God's kingdom?

Philippians 3:17-19

17. Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an example.

18. (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:

19. Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.)

What are you living for as a believer? What is the purpose of your existence as a believer?

2. Know You are Blessed To Be A Blessing.

God's blessings in our lives are not end in themselves. They are means to an end. The end being the advancement of His Kingdom on earth.

Luke 12:15-21

15. And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.

16. And he spake a parable unto them, saying, The ground of a certain rich man brought forth plentifully:

17. And he thought within himself, saying, What shall I do, because I have no room where to bestow my fruits?

18. And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods.

19. And I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry.

20. But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

21. So is he that layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God.

Your life does not consist of your possessions.

Your life consists in your donation/contributions to advancing God's Kingdom on earth.

Beneficiaries are in the kingdom just to advance themselves.

Stakeholders are committed to advancing God's kingdom on earth.

Genesis 12:1-2

1. Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:

2. And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing

When next you sing and claim Abraham's blessings, remember that Abraham's blessings are to make him a blessing.

Luke 1:67-75

67. And his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Ghost, and prophesied, saying,

68. Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people,

69. And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;

70. As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began:

71. That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us;

72. To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant;

73. The oath which he swore to our father Abraham,

74. That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear,

75. In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life.

3. Know God's Grace Is Abundantly Available

3. Know God's Grace Is Abundantly Available

1 Corinthians 3:10

According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon.

God has made His grace available to enable us be involved in the advancement of His kingdom on earth.

2 Corinthians 9:8

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:

1 Corinthians 15:10

But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.

4. Know that You have To Die To Self Interests

Philippians 2:19-22

19. But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy shortly unto you, that I also may be of good comfort, when I know your state.

20. For I have no man likeminded, who will naturally care for your state.

21. For all seek their own, not the things which are Jesus Christ's.

22. But ye know the proof of him, that, as a son with the father, he hath served with me in the gospel.

5. Your Spiritual Maturity

You have to grow spiritually. Your spiritual maturity affects your focus in life.

1 Corinthians 3:1-2

1. And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ.

2. I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able

There are too many immature believers in the Church today. They can't handle critical issues of the kingdom.

If for example, what I'm sharing now is rubbing you wrongly, it's a sign that you're still a baby in Kingdom matters.

Hebrews 5:12-14

12. For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.

13. For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.

14. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

6. Your Company

The company you keep will determine your participation in the kingdom.

1 Corinthians 5:9-13

9. I wrote unto you in an epistle not to company with fornicators:

10. Yet not altogether with the fornicators of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or with idolaters; for then must ye needs go out of the world.

11. But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.

12. For what have I to do to judge them also that are without? do not ye judge them that are within?

13. But them that are without God judgeth. Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person.

Evil communications corrupts.

1Cor 15:33-34

1 Corinthian 15:33-34

33. Do not be deceived: “Evil company corrupts good habits.”

34. Awake to righteousness, and do not sin; for some do not have the knowledge of God. I speak this to your shame.

You can only get evil communications from evil companies.

Proverb 27:17

Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend.

Surround yourself with relationships that will enhance your relevance in God’s kingdom

7.Your Focus

Your focus in life is everything. Your focus reveals your heart.

Your focus affects your commitments. Your focus affects your faithfulness.

Luke 12:31-34

31. But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you.

32. Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father’s good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

33. Sell that ye have, and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth corrupteth.

34. For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

We’re to focus on eternity are not just in this life.

We’re to focus on eternal things are not just things temporal

What we do and how we do things on earth depends on our focus.

1 Corinthians 3:10-15

10. According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon.

11. For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

12. Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble;

13. Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

14. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.

15. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

Let us be wise builders on earth. Let us build to last. Let us build what will matter in eternity.

Let us stop building what will not pass the test of God's fire of divine assessment.

8. Your Identity

John 18:37

Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.

When you don't have clear/correct understanding of your identity, you won't understand your purpose in life. Purpose is tied to identity.

9. The Work of Faith

The kingdom Advances by Faith. The Work of Advancing the kingdom is a supernatural work that can only be embarked upon by faith.

It is majorly a work of faith. You cannot embark on the work of Advancing God's naturally.

10. Full of God's power

The kingdom advances by force.

There are demonic resistances to the Advancing of the kingdom of God on earth.

Matthew 16:18

And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

It takes the power of God to pull down demonic resistance to the advance of God's kingdom.

11. Genuine Encounter of the Kingdom.

The kingdom operates from within us. Without a genuine Encounter of the kingdom, you can't be motivated to advance what you have not experienced.

Peter said what we have seen and experienced.

1 John 1:1-4.

1. That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;

2. (For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;)

3. That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

4. And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full.

12. Commitment to Intercession

A major key to advance God's Kingdom is commitment to intercession.
The Kingdom advances by prayers.

Acts 6:4

But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word.

They were not praying for themselves or their own needs.
