MAKING FULL PROOF OF YOUR MINISTRY

2 Timothy 4:1-8

I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry. For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

God has called us to fully express our calling - our ministry in our life time.

There's only one life time to do Ministry.

Paul said here I have finished my course - race.

Included in that race is your Ministry.

NEED FOR EXEMPLARY CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP

Now, the first thing I want us to see in this passage is that this book of Timothy was not written by Timothy.

The book of Timothy was written to Timothy by Apostle Paul who was a father and a more experienced Servant of God.

Today we need men/women whom God has helped and still helping to bring serious charge to Ministers of the Gospel in this generation.

If God through Apostle Paul could bring this serious charge to Timothy in his generation, I believe God is raising more serious charge to His Servants in this generation.

And I'm glad that God still has His Servants in this generation through whom He could charge His Ministers.

Men and women that God is helping not to lose focus in Ministry

For example, see how Apostle Paul described Himself.

1Tim 1:12-17

And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry; Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did it ignorantly in unbelief. And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus. This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief. Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting. Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the

only wise God, be honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

He described himself as someone who has obtained mercy and a pattern to those who afterwards would believe.

Ministry is what God will do in you first before He can do through you to others.

How would you describe yourself to a younger Minister?

What has been your experience with God?

Do you know that whatever the level of God's Grace upon your life, you have only obtained mercy?

Do you also know that you're a pattern?

What kind of a pattern are you?

Can people safely follow you?

Phil 3:17-19

Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample. (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.)

Philippians 3:17 Brethren, together follow my example and observe those who live after the pattern we have set for you.

Philippians 3:18 For there are many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, who walk (live) as enemies of the cross of Christ (the Anointed One).

Philippians 3:19 They are doomed and their fate is eternal misery (perdition); their god is their stomach (their appetites, their sensuality) and they glory in their shame, siding with earthly things and being of their party. (AMP)

UNDERSTANDING WHAT MINISTRY IS

The second thing I want us to see in this passage is understanding what Ministry is.

You can't make full proof of what you don't know.

1Tim 1:12

And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry

Ministry is what God puts men/women into.

Acts 20:22-24

And now, behold, I go bound in the spirit unto Jerusalem, not knowing the things that shall befall me there: Save that the Holy Ghost witnesseth in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions abide me. But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.

Ministry is what you received of the Lord

Col 4:17

And say to Archippus, Take heed to the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it.

Mk 3:13-15

And he goeth up into a mountain, and calleth unto him whom he would: and they came unto him. And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach, And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils:

Ministry is what you're ordained by God to do on earth

Your Ministry is your divine portion in God's assignment on earth.

It's God that's still doing Ministry

No one can do Ministry.

DANGEROUS PITFALLS

Another thing I want us to see in this passage in order to make full proof of our Ministry is the need to avoid some dangerous pitfalls.

2 Timothy 4:1-5

I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

Whatever is going on in the world is not new.

Past generations have also faced similar challenges.

The devil is the same devil in every generation and believe me, he doesn't have any new tricks.

Acts 1:15-20

And in those days Peter stood up in the midst of the disciples, and said, (the number of names together were about an hundred and twenty,) Men and brethren, this scripture must needs have been fulfilled, which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of David spake before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus. For he was numbered with us, and had obtained part of this ministry. Now this man purchased a field with the reward of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst asunder in the midst, and all his bowels gushed out. And it was known unto all the dwellers at Jerusalem; insomuch as that field is called in their proper tongue, Aceldama, that is to say, The field of blood. For it is written in the book of Psalms, Let his habitation be desolate, and let no man dwell therein: and his bishopric let another take.

If Judas who was called, Pastored and Mentored by Christ could miss it, then ANYONE can miss it.

I pray none of us shall miss it in Jesus Christ name

SOME TRUTHS ABOUT MINISTRY

1. Not about you - Ministry is not about you. It's about God and His purposes on earth.

Its not about your success, visibility or acceptance.

Gen 3:1-6

Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

This was how satan Got the first Ministers.

He made it about them.

Mt 4:1-11

Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred. And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple, And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God. Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the

kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me. Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.

Therefore it's not about how successful you become in life. We're not called to be successful. We're called to be faithful.

2. Not about financial/material status

1Pet 5:1-4

The elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be revealed: Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind; Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being ensamples to the flock. And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

3. Physical Structures

Gen 4:16-17

And Cain went out from the presence of the LORD, and dwelt in the land of Nod, on the east of Eden. And Cain knew his wife; and she conceived, and bare Enoch: and he builded a city, and called the name of the city, after the name of his son, Enoch.

Do you know that Judas has already purchased a land?

4. Followership/Size of congregation

Christ was never moved by numbers

Ministry is not a game of numbers.

Jn 6:66-68

From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him. Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away? Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.

5. Spiritual Gifts

Don't build your Ministry only on spiritual gifts.

Acts 20:28 - 32

Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood. For I know this, that after my departing shall grievous wolves enter in among you, not sparing the flock. Also of your own selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away disciples after them. Therefore watch, and remember, that by the space of three years I ceased not to warn every one night and day with tears.

And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.

It's the Word that feeds.

People don't grow on spiritual gifts. People grow on the word.

PART TWO

TEMPLATES TO MAKE FULL PROOF OF YOUR MINISTRY

TEMPLATES TO MAKE FULL PROOF OF YOUR MINISTRY

2Tim 4:1-5

1.I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; 2.Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

Now, from this passage, let's look at some Templates - for making full proof of your Ministry

1. Ministry Is Personal

Vs 1. I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;

2 Timothy 4:5

But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

God is a personal God. He deals with us on personal levels.

Col 4:17

And say to Archippus, take heed to the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it.

God's programs & purpose for us are personal.

Therefore, our walk & work with God are personal.

You have a personal, unique & individual relationship with God.

There are no two you. Your ministry, your assignment is unique to you.

You cannot compare yourself with any other person.

2 Corinthians 10:12

For we dare not make ourselves of the number, or compare ourselves with some that commend themselves: but they measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise.

God deals with us as individuals. Christianity is a personal walk & work with God.

The call of God is to every man on earth but its your personal response that makes the difference.

So Paul speaks to Timothy here personally.

Your call & your ministry makes you different from any other person.

That's what makes you a disciple. You've a master. You follow Him.

You're not like just anybody. You're different.

You can't afford to follow the crowd. You're in the world but not of the world.

Your focus, your desires, your passion must be different.

1 Corinthians 9:16-17

For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel! For if I do this thing willingly, I have a reward: but if against my will, a dispensation of the gospel is committed unto me.

1 Corinthians 9:16-17

For if I preach the gospel, that gives me no ground for boasting. For necessity is laid upon me. Woe to me if I do not preach the gospel! For if I do this of my own will, I have a reward, but if not of my own will, I am still entrusted with a stewardship.

2. Understand that your Ministry shall be judged

2Tim 4:1

1. I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;

2Cor 3:11-15

For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if any man build upon this foundation gold,

silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

3. Don't Change With The Weather

2Tim 4:2

Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

Be consistent in your convictions.

Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time is favorable or not. Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with good teaching. NLT

4. Preach The Word

2Tim 4:2

Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine

Not motivations.

Not philosophical nonsense

5. Don't Be Men Pleasers

2Tim 4:3-4

For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the

truth, and shall be turned unto fables.

6. Be Sound In Doctrine

2Tim 4:2-4

Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.

Christianity is built on doctrines

Eph 2:19-20

Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God; And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone;

Jude 1:3-4

Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

7. Watchfulness

2 Timothy 4:5

But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

Now, in order to make full proof of your Ministry, you must be watchful.

Why?

There are distractions.

Earthly, worldly, personal, & demonic distractions.

1 Peter 5:8

Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

How?

I) Have a clear vision of your ministry/assignment

Many workers don't have clear vision of their ministry.

Lack of clear vision will bring distractions & discouragement.

Acts 26:19-21

Whereupon, O king Agrippa, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision: But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance. For these causes the Jews caught me in the temple, and went about to kill me.

II) Commitment.

Be totally committed to your ministry.

Acts 6:4

But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word.

III) Faithfulness.

Ministry is a divine trust.

God had entrusted into your hands a divine purpose. That makes you a steward.

1 Corinthians 4:1-2

Chapter 4

Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God. Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.

2 Corinthians 4:1-2

Chapter 4

Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

IV) Develop Attitude Of Excellence.

God is an excellent God.

Don't be a mediocre in Ministry

Philippians 3:12-14

Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus. Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of

God in Christ Jesus.

Yesterday's excellence is today's mediocrity.

Excellence is improving daily.

Daniel 6:4

Then the presidents and princes sought to find occasion against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find none occasion nor fault; forasmuch as he was faithful, neither was there any error or fault found in him.

V) Develop Your Faith.

Ministry is by Grace

Ephesians 4:7

But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.

However, it's by faith that you access the Grace of Ministry.

Romans 5:2

By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Therefore, you need to develop your faith to access the Grace of God for your Ministry & overcome satanic distractions & assaults against your Ministry.

VI) Endure Hardship.

2 Timothy 4:5

But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

In order to make a full proof of your Ministry, you need to endure hardship as a soldier of Christ.

2 Timothy 2:3-4

Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

VII) Make A full Proof

2 Timothy 4:5

But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

Don't just do the Ministry. Make a full proof of it.

Do The Work. Give it all it takes.

Don't be a pretender. Be a doer.

Matthew 9:37

Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few;

Your Ministry is the reason for your existence.

Your Ministry is the basis of your reward in Heaven.

What you do and how you handle God's assignment in your hands now is what determine your place in eternity.

Acts 20:17-24

And from Miletus he sent to Ephesus, and called the elders of the church. And when they were come to him, he said unto them, Ye know, from the first day that I came into Asia, after what manner I have been with you at all seasons, Serving the Lord with all humility of mind, and with many tears, and temptations, which befell me by the lying in wait of the Jews: And how I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have shewed you, and have taught you publicly, and from house to house, Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ. And now, behold, I go bound in the spirit unto Jerusalem, not knowing the things that shall befall me there: Save that the Holy Ghost witnesseth in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions abide me. But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.

The kingdom of God on earth advances as every Christian worker is determined to make full proof of their Ministries
