Today we can see that many of the powerful truths and revelations that has come to the Church over the years to equip the Saints to impact the world are being misused for personal gains.

For example, the light/ revelation of God's Word on prosperity that has come to the Church is not for the Saints to compete with the world in physical material acquisitions and possessions but for expansion of God's kingdom on earth.

Paul told Timothy to rightly divide the Word.

However, the Word is being seriously wrongly divided in this end time.

The resultant effects?

The dwindling impact of the Church in the world.

Therefore the purpose of this retreat is to help redirect the focus of the Church and the leadership back to why the Church exists on earth .

EQUIPPING THE SAINTS IMPACTING THE WORLD.

2Tim 4:1-5

I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

As leaders/Ministers, we must be very sensitive to our kingdom assignment on earth.

The Lord spoke to me to ask us this question.

As a Pastor, are you feeding on your members ignorance?

Or are you feeding the Church of God which He has purchased with His own blood?

THE WHOLE ESSENCE OF OUR CALLING

Our assignment, our job, our calling is to equip the Church - which God has purchased with His own blood for her assignment on earth.

Acts 20:28

Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

The Church has assignments on earth.

And that assignment is to impact the world for God.

Therefore, as leaders, we must be very sensitive to this.

We're not to entertain the Church, we're to equip the Church.

2Tim 4:2-5

Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.

NLT

4:2 Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time is favorable or not. Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with good teaching.

4:3 For a time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching. They will follow their own desires and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear.

4:4 They will reject the truth and chase after myths.

4:5 But you should keep a clear mind in every situation. Don't be afraid of suffering for the Lord. Work at telling others the Good News, and fully carry out the ministry God has given you.

MSG

4:2 so proclaim the Message with intensity; keep on your watch. Challenge, warn, and urge your people. Don't ever quit. Just keep it simple.

4:3 You're going to find that there will be times when people will have no stomach for solid teaching, but will fill up on spiritual junk food—catchy opinions that tickle their fancy.

4:4 They'll turn their backs on truth and chase mirages.

4:5 But you—keep your eye on what you're doing; accept the hard times along with the good; keep the Message alive; do a thorough job as God's servant.

It's an equipped Church - a healthy Church, a Church without wrinkles & blemishes that can impact the world.

And that's the Church the Lord Jesus Christ is coming to rapture - a triumphant Church- a winning Church

Eph 5:25-27

Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

As leaders - Pastors, Apostles - Bishops - General Overseers, this is our assignment under God.

This is the whole essence of our callings.

Eph 4:11-12 (NKJV)

And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ,

THE SALT AND LIGHT

Mt 5:13-16

Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

The Church exists in the world as salt and light.

The bible didn't say ye are going to be salt - ye are going to be the light.

No.

The bible says ye are...

That's the spiritual composition of the Church - the authentic Church.

The authentic Church, the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ of which Christ is the Head is the salt and light of the world.

What does salt do? Attributes

Sweetens

Preserves

Unchangeable/Does not change/unaffected

What does light do?

Illuminate/brightens

Exposes

Direction

Attractive - can't be ignored

Irreplaceable/ Powerful - darkness can't overpower light

Can we say today's Church is fulfilling all these attributes?

No

Why?

Two major issues/reasons responsible for this.

NOT BUILDING THE AUTHENTIC CHURCH

Only the true Church - the authentic Church - the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ that can be salt and light.

Unfortunately, in the last 30 years or so, we stopped building the authentic Church of Christ.

1Jn 2:18-19

Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time. They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would no doubt have continued with us: but they went out, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us.

Today's Church doesn't look like Christ.

Today's Church is largely anti - Christ

They're in the Church building but never part of Christ so they can't look like Him.

They don't have His DNA in them

Acts 20:28-30

Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood. For I know this, that after my departing shall grievous wolves enter in among you, not sparing the flock. 30. Also of your own selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away disciples after them.

Today many in Ministry are no longer raising the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ

They're raising their own followers/disciples

How?

1. When Ministers preach salvation without conviction and repentance - just come as you are....they're not raising the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ

Act 2:37

Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

It's conviction that leads to genuine repentance and genuine conversion

2. When preachers are praying salvation prayers with unrepentant sinners

Act 2:38

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

3. When Ministers preach Christ as Saviour only and not Christ as also Lord they're not raising the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ

2 Pet 3:17-18

Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own steadfastness. But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.

4. When Ministers are not raising disciples they're not raising the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Mt 28:18-20

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

5. When Ministers are preaching prosperity without emphasizing holiness they're raising covetous people and not the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ

Lk 12:13-15

And one of the company said unto him, Master, speak to my brother, that he divide the inheritance with me. And he said unto him, Man, who made me a judge or a divider over you? And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.

COLD AND LUKEWARM

The second issue involved is the issue of the Church becoming cold and look-warm.

This is the issue where the Church has lost its saltiness and the light had become deemed.

This is the issue of the Church not being able to endure sound doctrine but would rather have teachers satisfying their itching ears.

This is the issue of the Church not having enough oil to last till the Bridegroom returns.

Mt 25:1-13

Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom. And five of them were wise, and five were foolish. They that were foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them: But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him. Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out. But the wise answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves. And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut. Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us. But he answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I know you not. Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh.

WHAT THE CHURCH NEEDS TO IMPACT THE WORLD

Let's look at the equipping the Church needs to be able to fully impact the world.

What kind of equipping does the Church need?

Some thinks the Church needs financial equipment

Some thinks it's political equipment

Some thinks is social equipment etc.

However from seeing the need of the world - What the world lacks we can conclude it's spiritual equipment that the Church needs.

The Church needs to be spiritually equipped.

Acts 20:28

Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

1 Pet 5:1-4

The elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be revealed: Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind; Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being ensamples to the flock. And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

Beloved, the preoccupation of the early church leaders was the equipping of the Church.

The results?

Acts 17:5-6

But the Jews which believed not, moved with envy, took unto them certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people. And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;

This passage shows us that the early Church fully impacted their world.

They fully carried out the instructions of the Lord Jesus Christ

These ones were not just preoccupied with their needs.

This used to be the state of the Church too.

Mt 28:18-20.

The assignment of the Church on earth is to make disciples of the nations not to go compete with the world in material acquisitions

The Church is the people that have be taken out of the world even though they're still in the world.

You can't be part of the world and still impact the world

Jn 15:18-19

If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you. If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.

What distinction can you see between the Church and the world today?

SPIRITUAL EQUIPMENTS THE CHURCH NEEDS

Let's look at the equipment the Church needs to be able to fully impact the world. These equipment is the assignment/job description of everyone called into any of the five fold Ministries

Eph 4:7-12

If you're an Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist Pastor & Teacher here tonight, the present state of the Church rests squarely on your shoulders.

Why?

You've been called, anointed and graced in Christ for the task of equipping the the

1. Death

Th first spiritual equipping the Church needs is death - death to self.

Jn 12:23-26

And Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should be glorified. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit. He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal. If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour.

Now, how does the Church comes to the place of death?

When we preach the cross.

1Cor 1:18

For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

The preaching of the cross will bring people to

- A. Genuine Encounter with God's Life - Being born again
- B. Deliverance From contrary spirits
- C. Encounter with the power - - Baptism of the Holy Spirit
- D. Water Baptism - identification with Christ's death, burial & resurrection.

2. Discipleship

What we have in many assemblies today are converts who have never been disciplined.

Ten, fifteen, twenty years in the Lord but had never been disciplined.

Our assignment is to make disciples.

Mt 28:18-20

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

It was because of 120 disciples that the Church still exists today.

Eph 4:11-16

And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ— from whom the whole body, joined

and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

I. Discipleship will bring Renewal of the the mind

II. Understanding the will of God - knowing/understanding her true identity

III. separation from the world -

many of the teachings going on today fits into 1TIM...able to endure sound doctoring..heep up teachers,

therefore can't help the Church to know her through identity. The Church will keep conforming to the world for as long as these teachings are rampant in the Church.

IV. Helps the Church to know her assignment on earth.

There's a reason the Church is on earth

Lk 19:12-13

He said therefore, A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom, and to return. And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come.

The Church is an occupying force on earth - not a spectator to be dazzled by the bling bling of the world

V. Helps the Church to be deployed - be a going & not a sitting Church - mission oriented.

Act 1:8

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

VI. Helps the Church must stop celebrating what God is not celebrating

Phil 2:19-20

But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timotheus shortly unto you, that I also may be of good comfort, when I know your state. For I have no man likeminded, who will naturally care for your state. For all seek their own, not the things which are Jesus Christ's.

Lk 10:17-20

And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

VI. Helps the Church's focus - focus on eternity

Tit 2:12-15

For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ; Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee.

THE IMPACT THE WORLD NEEDS

There's only one reason the Church exists on earth - to impact the world.

Outside of this, the Church has no business being in the world.

Think about it.

What's the Church doing on earth?

The Church is the Body of Christ made up of individuals who have been washed in the Blood of the Lamb & called out the world.

The question is why?

2 Cor 4:1-5

Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them

satan is the god of this world.

satan is the one manipulating and influencing the world against God.

The Church exists to counter the influence of satan over man on earth.

The assignment of the Church is therefore to impact the world against satanic influence.

Unfortunately the Church today is totally ignorant of this.

Many people in the Church only thinks about their needs.

God meeting your needs is not an end but a means for you to fulfill your assignment of Impacting the world.

Mt 16:18

And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.

From this scripture, we see that what God is doing on earth is building/equipping His Church so that the gates of hell would not prevail against the advance of His Church on earth.

And His instruments for this assignment are His Servants.

Acts 17:5-6

But the Jews which believed not, moved with envy, took unto them certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people. And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;

In what way does God want the Church to impact the world?

To answer this we need to answer another question

What does the world lack?

I believe this is where the Church has seriously missed it.

The focus of the Church should never be the focus of the world as it's been the case in these days

1Jn 2:15-17

Jam 4:4-5

The greatest deception in the Church of this century is to think money is equal to prosperity.

Brethren, Jesus didn't die for you to make money.

You don't need Christ to make money.

Listen to Christ's warning about money.

Lk 12:15

1 Tim 6:6-20

You can see here that the Lord is not against those who're rich in this world.

You can also see here that you don't really need Him to be rich in this world.

There's an eternal difference between being rich in this world & being rich in Christ.

The beautiful truth is that you can be both - this is a very dangerous combination that satan is very very afraid of.

Most of those who're rich in Christ are not rich in this world & many of those who're rich in the world are not rich in Christ.

The world does not lack money. The world does not lack fame. The do not lack for success etc

What does the world lack?

- 1 Righteousness - exalts a righteous man is a truthful man
2. Faithfulness - you don't find faithful people in the world
3. Commitments - the world lacks commitment
4. Fearlessness - the world is fearful
5. Integrity - the world lacks integrity
6. Excellence - the world lacks excellence
7. Love - the world is selfish
